Common Name: Cocora

Scientific Name: Guarea grandifolia

Botanical Family: Meliaceae





This species grows at low and medium elevations, in humid or very humid forests of our country.

Generally, this tree reaches a height of 10 to 30 m, having a trunk with small table roots at the base. The outer bark is characterized by its brown color and is internally pink. Paripinnate and alternate leaves, with 6 to 22 pairs of leaflets, opposite in the rachis.

The leaves of juvenile plants can reach more than 1 m in length, but in adults they are smaller. This species is idoic, with white and aromatic flowers, its fruits are presented in oblong or ellipsoidal capsules and in the shape of pears, from 3.5 to 6 cm long, green, turning brown and dehiscent brown when ripe. These seeds with red or orange bark are very sought after by birds and rodents in Costa Rica.
